Dear Friend,

One of the laws of Passover is the one that pertains to the negation of all Chametz that is in one's possession during the period of Passover.

In order to avoid this difficulty, the Halacha provides that the Chametz may be sold to a non-Jew (for whom the laws of Passover are not binding).

The Rabbi to whom you give the power of attorney is the one who serves to transact the sale. For your convenience, we are making available the enclosed contract. All you have to do is fill it out and either email it to rabbi@jewishlincoln.com or mail it to the following address. After the Holiday your Chametz will be "bought back" by the Rabbi.
